February: Spiritual Works of Mercy – Admonishing the Sinner – Reflection by Monique Sammut

*"To admonish the sinner begins by admonishing oneself." Saint Jerome*

When I was a kid, it seemed like you could never blame anyone by pointing a finger at them because someone would very quickly point out that three of your fingers were pointing back at you. When we hear exhortations such as "admonish the sinner," we might be tempted to analyze, correct, and judge others without sparing ourselves any thought.

Admonishing the sinner is multifaceted. There are many moments when we can offer the truth with love to those around us. However, in addition to caring for the welfare of the souls around us, we must also take care of our own souls. Not one of us is without sin, and therefore, we must, as Jesus stated, "*remove the wooden beam from [our eyes] first; then [we] will see clearly to remove the splinter from [our] brother's eye.*" Admonishing the sinner does not make us superior to others. God uses each of us to bring others to Himself. So, in following this Spiritual Work of Mercy, let us be instruments of salvation in God's hands, so that through us, He may "draw all men to [Himself]."
