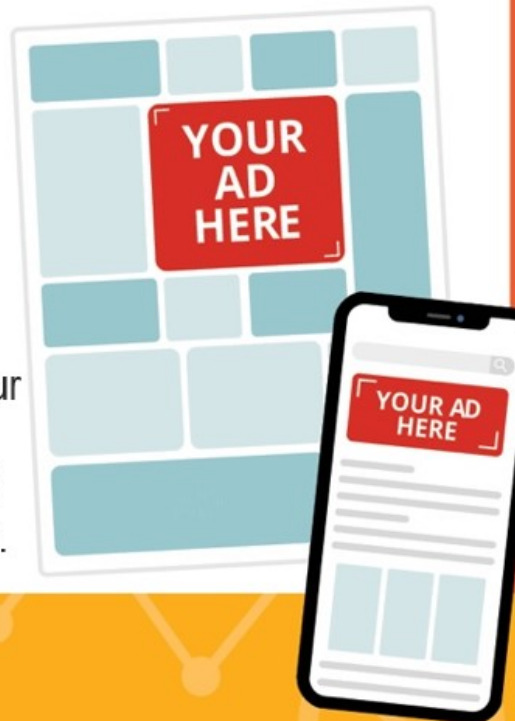

We are again blessed with the problem of growth and needing more space – as well as maintaining the facilities that are the platform for us to teach, form and evangelize our students.



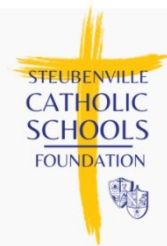

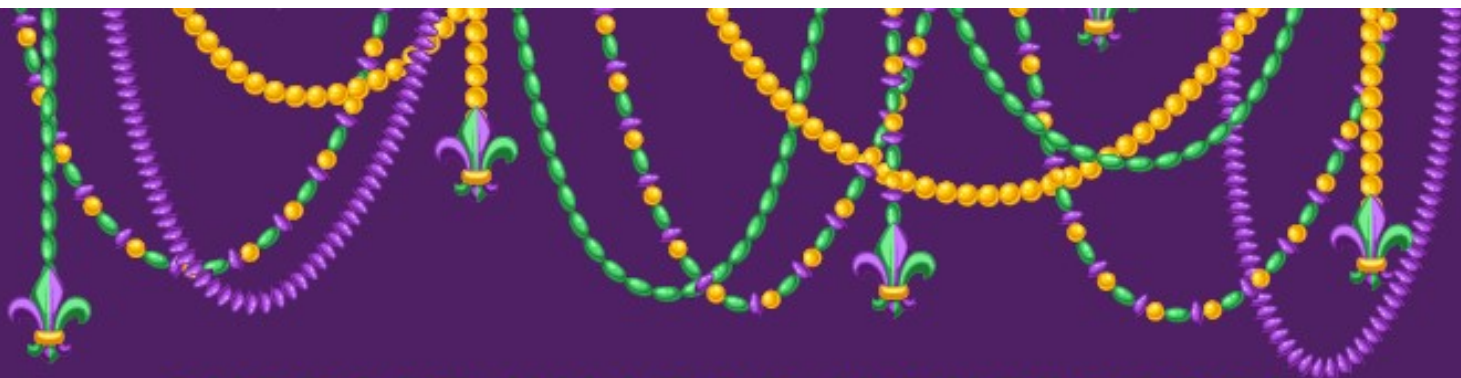
