We are again blessed with the problem of growth and needing more space – as well as maintaining the facilities that are the platform for us to teach, form and evangelize our students.












Bishop Bradley will celebrate the sacrament of Confirmation on Saturday, April 6, 2024, at the 4:00 pm Mass.
