Fridays of Lent

On Fridays during Lent, **Mass** will be celebrated at 5:15 pm (in addition to the usual 8:00 am Mass) and **Stations of the Cross** will be prayed at **6 pm**. There will be a simple, vegetarian potluck in the Church Hall after Stations. If you plan on attending, please bring a meatless dish to share.

Fasting and Abstinence in Lent

Lent is a season of penance. Fasting & abstinence are essential means by which we celebrate Lent. The laws of the Catholic Church (Code of Canon Law: 1251-52) on fasting & abstinence are as follows:

Abstinence

All Catholics 14 years and older are obliged to abstain from eating flesh meat on the Fridays of Lent.

Fasting

Catholics aged 18 to 59 inclusive are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On these days of fasting, one full meal is permitted as well as two smaller meals that, if combined, would be less than a full meal.

2024 Sacrament Dates at Saint Peter's

- First Penance—10:30 am on May 4
- ♦ First Communion—10 am on May 5
 - ♦ **Confirmation**—4 pm on April 6

First Penance & Communion are celebrated in 2nd grade (*child MUST be at least 7 years* old as of 1/1/2024) & Confirmation in the 5th grade.


