### **Fasting and Abstinence in Lent**

Lent is a season of penance. Fasting & abstinence are essential means by which we celebrate Lent. The laws of the Catholic Church (Code of Canon Law: 1251-52) on fasting & abstinence are as follows:

**Abstinence:** All Catholics 14 years & older are obliged to abstain from eating flesh meat on the Fridays of Lent.

**Fasting:** Catholics aged 18 to 59 inclusive are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On these days of fasting, one full meal is permitted as well as two smaller meals that, if combined, would be less than a full meal.

### April: The Virtues of Mary – Ardent Charity – Reflection by Monique Sammut

*(Ardent Charity: Letting her love for God be the driving force behind every decision)*

*“God is love. Thus, when we love with the love of charity, our actions are the actions of God.”*  
~ Marc Foley

I once participated in a two week volunteer program with the Carmelite Sisters of the Most Sacred Heart of Los Angeles along with several other women. During our time in the program, the sisters wanted us to keep an eye out for ways to love and serve each other, but we also had to be receptive to receiving this love and service. Every morning, a few of us would take care of making breakfast. On this particular morning, it was my group’s turn, and we were running very behind for some reason. By the time I sat down to eat, everyone was basically finished, and I had to hurry so we could leave on time. I sat down with my plate and a glass of water feeling very flustered and rushed and only then realized that my glass was dirty. I stood up a bit angrily to get a new glass knowing this would make me even later. One of the other women saw this, took the glass from me, and told me to sit and eat while she found me a new glass. When I protested, she said simply, “Let me love you.”

I thought of this story because a friend of mine recently sent me a quote by Saint Elizabeth of the Trinity: *“Let yourself be vulnerable. Let your walls down, your carefully constructed fortresses breached, your fiercely guarded heart laid bare. Let your wounds be touched, your fears revealed, your deepest desires, damaged dreams, and most daring hopes unveiled before the Bridegroom, who has the power to redeem, restore, and resurrect them. Drop your independence and the idea – which you clutch so tightly – that you can do anything to protect and save yourself. And LET HIM LOVE YOU.”*

So how do these tie together with Ardent Charity? Jon Bloom said, *“The most loving thing we can do for others is love God more than we love them. For if we love God most, we will love others best.”* But as John 4:19 says, *“We love because He first loved us.”* In order to love others well, we must place our love for God first. But to do that, we must first open our hearts in the way Saint Elizabeth of the Trinity described so that we can receive the tremendous love of God. When we live in the love of the Father, we can then take that love and share it with those around us. Sharing God’s love with others doesn’t have to be anything fancy. Even the small act of finding me a new glass of water when I was stressed and running behind was a gesture of love and service I have never forgotten. In the movie *Evan Almighty*, “God” tells Evan, *“You want to know how to change the world, son? One Act of Random Kindness at a time.”* Let us take the time to reflect on the unimaginable love of God so that we can take the love we receive and share it with those around us through small (or great) acts of love and service. By allowing God’s love to change us, by allowing Him to act through us, we are sharing Him, in our own unique and personal way, with the world.
