

### **Fasting and Abstinence in Lent**

Lent is a season of penance. Fasting & abstinence are essential means by which we celebrate Lent. The laws of the Catholic Church (Code of Canon Law: 1251-52) on fasting & abstinence are as follows:

**Abstinence:** All Catholics 14 years & older are obliged to abstain from eating flesh meat on the Fridays of Lent.

**Fasting:** Catholics aged 18 to 59 inclusive are obliged to fast on Good Friday. On days of fasting, one full meal is permitted as well as two smaller meals that, if combined, would be less than a full meal.

Everyone is invited to the **Cathedral of Saint Joseph in Wheeling on Good Friday, April 18, at 12:45 pm** for a moving reflection on **The Seven Last Words of Christ**. Through brief meditations by seven local priests and sacred music by the Cathedral Schola, this beautiful devotion will guide us in prayerful reflection on Jesus' final words from the Cross—words of love, mercy, suffering, and hope.

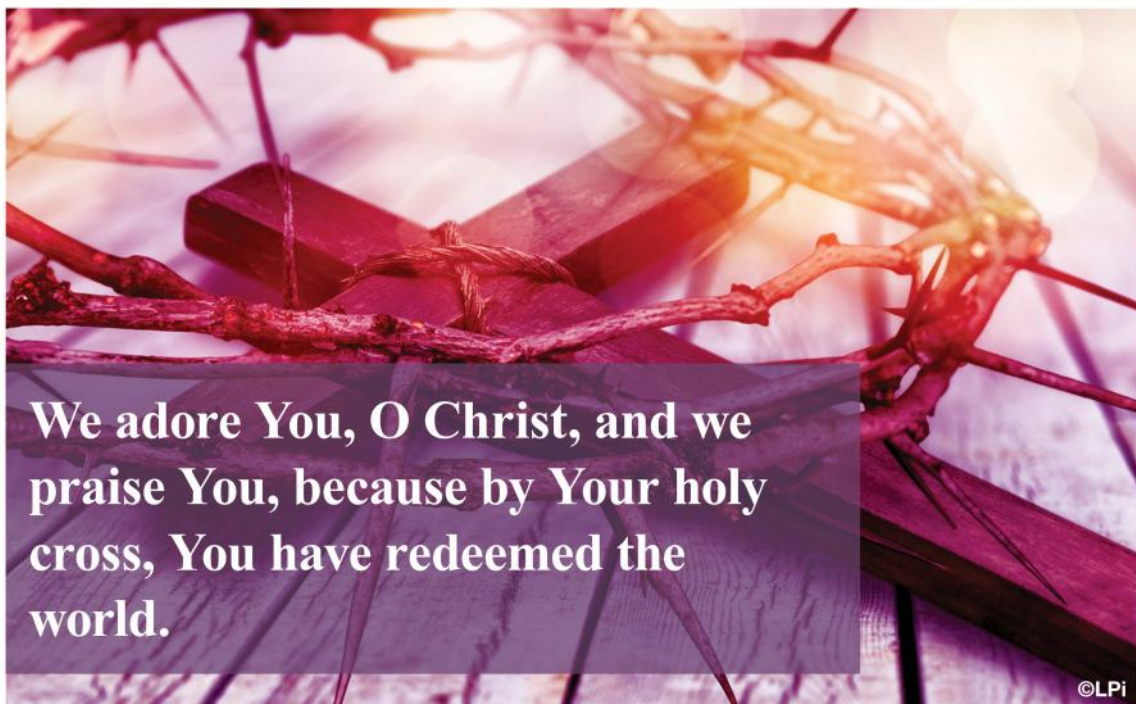

**2024 Donor’s Bulletin/ Newsletter/ Pulpit Announcement:**

**Attention all Ohio State Taxpayers!**

Did you pay Ohio State taxes for the 2023 tax year? Did you know that a Scholarship Tax Credit program exists, which makes it possible to make a **no-net-cost** gift that will turn your Ohio tax dollars into tuition for students of any Catholic school you designate in the Diocese of Steubenville?

**How does it work?** It’s simple- make a contribution to the **Christ the Teacher Diocesan Scholarship Fund (CTDSF)** by April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025, that will be eligible for a non-refundable 100% tax credit of up to \$750 (\$1,500 if married filing jointly) against your 2024 state tax liability. CTDSF will send you a tax receipt for filing your 2024 state income taxes; And notify the designated school of your contribution.

#### Notes:

- ❖ Line 8c- Income tax liability before credits-
  - This is the amount of Ohio Income Tax owed
- ❖ Line 9- Ohio nonrefundable credits
  - Includes amount donated to ASF
  - Maximum amount is \$750 for individuals or \$1,500 for married couples filing jointly, where each spouse gives \$750
  - This amount cannot be greater than line 8c
  - This amount is subtracted from the amount on line 8c
- ❖ Line 10- Tax liability after nonrefundable credits
  - Ohio Income Tax owed after subtracting nonrefundable credits
  - Cannot be less than \$0 (e.g., if line 8c is \$500, the maximum amount for line 9 is \$500)
