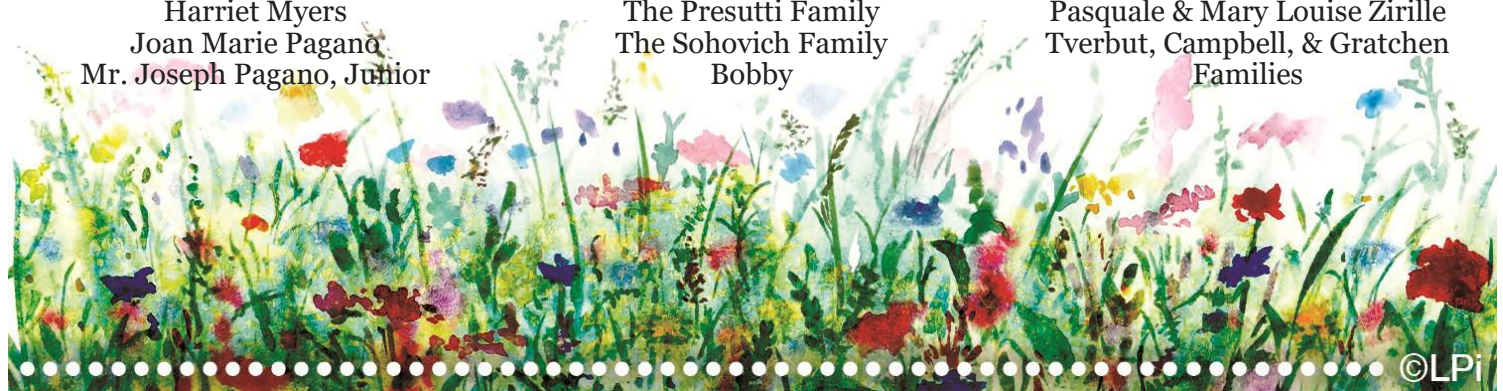

**May: The Virtues of Mary – Heroic Patience – Reflection by Monique Sammut**

*(Heroic Patience: Always trusting that God was on the move; having more faith in His plans than her own)*

*“God is constantly on the move. I cannot stay where I am and follow God at the same time; responding requires movement.” ~ Margaret Feinberg*

Early on in the movie *Evan Almighty*, Evan’s wife Joan prays that they will grow closer as a family. As the events of the movie unfold, Joan thinks her husband, Evan, has gone crazy and leaves with their three boys to get away for a while. While they’re eating lunch, the waiter (God), stops and talks to Joan. She tells him about Evan, and he tells her how the story of Noah’s Ark is a love story about believing in each other. He explains how the animals stood together in pairs just as Noah and his family stood together. He tells Joan, “[It] sounds like an opportunity. Let me ask you something. If someone prays for patience, do you think God gives them patience? Or does he give them the opportunity to be patient? If they pray for courage, does God give them courage, or does he give them opportunities to be courageous? If someone prayed for their family to be closer, do you think God zaps them with warm fuzzy feelings, or does he give them opportunities to love each other?”

I think when we pray, we sometimes expect God to immediately answer our prayers the way we want Him to answer them without requiring much work on our part. Or, we tend to be like George Bailey in *It’s a Wonderful Life*, and we think we know “what [we’re] gonna do tomorrow, and the next day, and the next year, and the year after that,” and when we pray, we just want God to fit His plans inside ours – for Him to make our will for our lives possible instead of making His will for our lives known. The virtue of Heroic Patience encourages us to surrender what we want and what we think is best, as well as the timing, into the hands of the One who has a plan we can’t see and to trust that God’s will for our lives is better than anything we could come up with by ourselves. It can be terrifying when the road ahead remains shrouded in mystery, but if we seek God’s will in every aspect of our lives, we will find freedom and rest, for as Dante says in *Paradiso*, “in His will there is our peace.”
